



Fee Schedule

Winter 2025 - Summer 2026 Season

The Socorro Farmers' Market charges a vendor fee for each vendor. This helps the SFM Board pay for business licenses, SNAP, advertising, paper work, membership with the New Mexico Farmers Marketing Association (NMFMA), fuel costs, salary for the Market Manager (MM), and other supplies.

SFM is a year round market. Winter market runs November 1 to May 31. Summer market runs June 1 to October 31.

Vendors have the option to pay fees on a yearly, seasonal (winter/summer) or daily schedule. Yearly and Seasonal Vendors become a Member of the Socorro Farmers' Market (SFM). All other vendors are considered Day Vendors. Non-profits are welcome at the SFM and will be considered a day vendor with a distinct fee schedule.

Day Vendors:

- Will pay a fee each market day.
- Will be assigned space by the MM based on availability each market day.
- Daily fees are \$10/day/space during the winter and summer market.

Seasonal and Yearly Vendors:

- Shall pay in advance for the season or the full year.
- Shall receive a reserved vending space.
- Seasonal fees are \$125 for winter market and \$200 for summer market.
- Yearly fees are \$275.
- Seasonal fees are due at the Vendor's first vending day of the season.
- Yearly fees are due in November, or at the Vendor's first vending day of the year.

Non-Profits

- Non-Profit for fundraising- \$5/day/space year round
- Non-Profit organizations- Free only to provide information

Vending fees are reviewed and voted on by the SFM Board annually. By signing the Vendor Agreement, the vendor agrees to pay the fees as outlined above.

Payments shall be made to the MM either by check or cash. The MM will provide a receipt. Please make all checks payable to: Socorro Farmers Market.
